Getting There

The best way to arrive in Greenwich is by boat along the Thames, why not spend the day in Greenwich?

Otherwise mainline trains run from Charing Cross (takes 17 minutes), Waterloo (13 minutes) and London Bridge (10 minutes). Greenwich Station is two minutes from Davy's Wine Vaults. Leave the station and turn right.

The last train to town is at 2332, an earlier one leaves at 2302.

The N1 night bus runs all night.
